BUDGET & PRECEPT 2007/8

At the November meeting, the Parish Council approved its budget for 2007/2008 resulting in the precept remaining unchanged at £28,000. The precept is a small part of the council tax, set by the Parish Council, to fund Parish projects, maintenance and improvements. It has not been increased for four years now and equates to just over £30 per household for the year.

ROADSIDE SEATING

There will shortly be two new seats in the Village.

Thanks to the Women's Section of the Royal British Legion, there will be a seat on the green on Booth Bed Lane, facing Meadow Avenue. The location has special significance to the organisation as it was here that the charge was read to their first Standard before it was paraded to St. Luke's Church for dedication.

Another seat will be placed at the junction of Main Road and Bank View which it is hoped will be particularly welcomed by residents waiting for the local buses. This seat has been selected for its construction from recycled material which does not rot, fade or discolour and does not require painting or staining.
