GOOSTREY STATION

Network Rail have erected a new shelter at the station. The canopy over the north-bound platform will soon be cut back by half to improve visibility of the new signals but, as this will not provide sufficient shelter from wet and windy weather, the additional shelter has been provided. The decorative metal brackets and wooden fascia of the original canopy will be retained and repainting of the entire building is planned. There is also a new notice board on the end of the station building, displaying rail-related and other community information.

VILLAGE HALL – TOILET FACILITIES

Cheshire County Council has now started an investigation into the causes of the damp in the corridor and toilets at the Village Hall. The Parish Council hopes that a thorough investigation and necessary repairs & refurbishment will proceed without delay. It will then be possible to refit and modernise the toilets to provide hirers with much more attractive facilities. All regular hirers of the Hall will be kept informed of any likely disruption.
