OVERHANGING TREES, BUSHES & HEDGES

The Parish Council respectfully asks all residents who have properties with public pavements and paths on their boundaries to make sure that all overhanging branches are removed, at least to above head height, and that hedges are cut back sufficiently so as not to encroach onto pavements, making them too narrow to negotiate safely.
